ORDER

Whereas, Sri Binakar Tandi bearing Roll No. 151610600316 is a candidate for the post of Junior Clerk-2016, the preliminary examination of which was held on 22.09.2019 at Govt. Autonomous College, Bhawanipatna.

Whereas, Centre Superintendent Govt. Autonomous College, Bhawanipatna vide letter No.Nil dtd.22.09.2019 reported that the above named candidate was found in possession of a mobile phone and it was suspected that he used the said mobile phone for ulterior motive. The Superintendent further reported that FIR concerning the matter has been lodged in the local Police Station. A copy of FIR was enclosed with his report.

On receipt of the report, Sri Binakar Tandi was given an opportunity to put forth his views/explanation/show cause vide this Commission's letter No.3590/OSSC dtd.2.11.2019 under Rule-18 of OSSC Rules. Sri Tandi has submitted a written statement of defense stating that he has kept the mobile phone with him in a hurry as he covered a long distance from his native place which is situated in a remote place. He had no malafide intention to misuse the mobile phone.

Whereas all the candidates appearing the examination were issued with admission letter containing a set of instructions to be followed by the candidate where it is clearly indicated that non compliance of the instruction will lead to disqualification of candidature. It has been categorically instructed that possession of mobile phone inside the examination centre shall lead to disqualification. It was prohibited vide Sl. No.4 of the instruction in the admission letter. The candidate should not be allowed to the examination centre if he/she is in possession of a mobile phone. Adequate arrangement was also made in the examination centre for frisking. But it appears that the candidate Sri Tandi could manage to avoid the frisking team and entered the examination hall with mobile phone, which was detected by the invigilator. There are clear instructions in the advertisement prohibiting a candidate to carry mobile phone and other communication device into the premises of OSSC examination Centre. Any infringement of the instructions will entail

debarment of the concerned candidate from the examination. The same has also been reiterated in the admission letter as mentioned above.

Whereas, Commission have carefully gone through the report of Centre Superintendent, the explanation/show cause given by the candidate in writing and examined the provision contained in Odisha Staff Selection Commission Rules-18 as amended upto date and have come to the conclusion that the candidate Sri Binakar Tandi have violated the instruction contained in Advertisement as well as in the Admission letter and therefore Commission in exercise of power vested under Rule-18 of OSSC Rule-1993 and as amended update have been pleased not to evaluate his answer paper for the examination to the post Junior Clerk-2016 and debar him from further participation in recruitment examination to the post of Junior Clerk-2016.


