- ii) No Detailed Application Form (DAF) is required to be sent to Odisha Staff Selection Commission. Candidates who will be shortlisted and called for certificate verification have to produce their original certificates and self attested photocopies of DAF enclosing all required documents for verification.
- iii) The candidates applying for the post must go through the detailed advertisement and ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility criteria prescribed for the post as laid down in the advertisement. Admission of a candidate for the written examination & other Tests shall be provisional and would be on the basis of the information furnished by him/her in the Online Application form only.
- iv) If at any stage of recruitment or thereafter, it is found that any information furnished by the candidate in his/her online application is false/incorrect or the candidate has suppressed any relevant information or the candidate otherwise does not satisfy the eligibility criteria for the post, his/her candidature for the Post/examination will be cancelled forthwith and he may be debarred from appearing any further recruitment examination (s) conducted by OSSC either temporarily or permanently.

SCALE OF PAY: The appointment will be initially on contractual basis carrying a consolidated pay comprising of initial pay+ grade pay in the scale of pay of Rs. Rs.9300/- to Rs. 34,800/- and G.P. of Rs.4200/- (Pre-revised) subject to revision by the Government from time to time.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE: Appointment to the post shall be guided by Odisha Group-B posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules, 2013 notified vide G.A. Department Notification No. GAD-SC-Rules-0061-2013-1147/Gen dt. 17.01.2014 and as amended up to date and the Condition of services shall be governed by concerned Rules in vogue.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- i) Age: Must not be below 21 years and above 32 years of age as on 01.01.2017. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of ST & Women candidates, 10 years relaxation in case of PWD category candidates, by the period of qualifying years of service rendered in Defence Forces in case of Ex-SM Candidates and below 45 years as on 01.01.2017 in case of In-Service Contractual Employees.
- ii) Educational Qualification: To be eligible for the post, the candidate must possess Diploma in Fine Arts & Crafts from a recognised University.

PLAN OF EXAMINATION: (a) Paper-I Composite Paper (English, Odia, General Studies) - 1 & ½ Hrs-100 Marks  
Paper-II Technical paper-1 & ½ Hrs-100 Marks
