- (ii) Candidates are required to apply through online mode only after publication of detailed Advertisement in OSSC website.
- (iii) PWD candidates are not eligible to apply for the post.
- (iv) Before applying for the post the candidates must go through the detailed Advertisement & ensure their eligibility for the post.
- (v) On the basis of the information given in the online application form the candidates will be allowed to appear different stages of examination and if at any stage it is found that he/she has furnished false or incorrect information his/her candidature will be rejected forthwith.
- (vi) Candidates have to download call letter from the above website for appearing the examination at different stages of recruitment. No call letter will be sent to candidates by post.

SCALE OF PAY: The appointment will be initially on contractual basis carrying a monthly remuneration of Rs.16,880/- for 1st year, (for 2nd year- Rs.18,570/-per month, for 3rd year-Rs.20,430/- per month, 4th year- Rs.22,480/- per month, for 5th year-Rs.24,730/- per month and for 6th year-27,210/- per month) as per Odisha Group-B Posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules,2013 and amended up to date.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE: Condition of Service for the post shall be governed by the Odisha Police Service (Conditions of service and Method of Recruitment of Sub-Inspectors, handwriting Bureau, CID, CB) Rules, 2011 and (Amendment) Rules-2018, notified by Govt. in Home Department Notification No.20319-Home-D&A dated 07.05.2018 and the conditions of service to the post shall be guided by Odisha Group-B posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules,2013 and as amended up to date.

ELIGIBILITY

- i) **Age:** Must not be below 21 years and above 25 years of age as on 1.1.2018.
- ii) **Upper age relaxation limit:** 5 years in case of ST, SC, SEBC Category and all Women candidates and period of service rendered in armed forces in case of Ex-SM. In-Service Contractual Employees who have rendered at least one year of service prior to commencement of the contractual Rules-2013 and are below 45 years of age as on 01.01.2018 are also eligible to apply for the post.
- iii) **Educational Qualification:** Must be a Science Graduate in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics from any recognised University The candidates who have not taken Odia as a subject in H.S.C standard , must possess requisite certificate of passing at least ME standard in Odia as language subject.


