- ii) Candidates are required to apply through Online Mode only after publication of the detailed advertisement in the OSSC.
- iii) PwD candidates are not eligible to apply for the post.
- iv) Before applying for the post the candidate must go through the Detail Advertisement and ensure their eligibility for the post.
- v) On the basis of information given in the Online Application Form the candidate will be allowed to appear different stages of examination and if at any stage it is found that he/she has furnished false or incorrect information his/her candidature will be rejected forthwith.
- iv) Candidates have to download admission letter from the above website for appearing the examination at different stages of recruitment. No Admission letter will be sent to candidates by post.

SCALE OF PAY:- The appointment will be initially on contractual basis carrying a monthly recruitment of Rs. 16,880/- for 1st year.(for 2nd year-Rs. 18,570/-per month, for 3rd year-20,430/-, for 4th year-Rs. 22,480/-per month, 5th year-24,730/- per month and 6th year-27,210/- per month) as per Odisha Group-B posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules, 2013 and amended up to date.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE: Conditions of Service for the post shall be governed by the Odisha Welfare (Research and Training) Service (Methods of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) of the officers of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe Research and Training Institute Rules, 2012 and the conditions of service to the post shall be guided by Odisha Group-B posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules, 2013 and amended up to date.

ELIGIBILITY

- i) Age- Must not be below 21 years and above 32 years of age as on 1.1.2018.
- ii) Upper age relaxation limit- 5 years in case of SC,ST, SEBC and Women candidates & total period of service rendered in Defence Forces in case of Ex servicemen. In-service Contractual Employees who have rendered at least one year of service prior to commencement of the contractual Rules-2013 and are below 45 years of age as on 01.01.2018 are also eligible to apply for the post
- iii) Minimum Educational Qualification- The minimum educational qualification for the post is Master Degree in Anthropology/ Tribal Studies/ Sociology/ Social Works/ Applied Economics/ Statistics from any University or Institutions recognised by Government with atleast 55% mark with practical knowledge of Computer Applications. Preference shall be given to the candidates having an M.Phil or Ph.D Degree in their respective field of specialisation.
